



North Swanbourne Beach Users Association

I. BACKGROUND

As a result of widespread concern over the future of North Swanbourne Beach as a nude bathing area a public meeting was called on Dec 4th 1979 and the NSBUA formed. Since that date the NSBUA has directed its attention towards

- (i) increasing public awareness of the fact that North Swanbourne beach users represent a large and orderly group determined to gain community acceptance;
- (ii) initiating a working relationship with the Nedlands City Council to examine possible solutions to the Swanbourne parking and amenities problems;

- (iii) organising a formal petition to change the existing State Police Act obscenity law to legalise nude bathing in restricted areas (specified by local authorities) along the WA coast.

At the last meeting of the NSBUA on March 11th 1980 it was unanimously agreed to continue and intensify work in all the above areas until the future of the nudist beach is assured. The following positions were filled for 1980:-

II. THE PRESENT SITUATION

The single most important blow of recent weeks has been an apparent hardening of the Government's attitude, despite the increasing popularity of the beach. Once again the onus is on us to ensure the continuing existence of this unique site.

Despite this frustrating turn of events, the Nedlands City Council has taken two further initiatives to provide parking space. It will

- (i) approach the Commonwealth Govt in an effort to secure the use of the Alfred Road extension to the nudist beach;
- (ii) approach the Public Works Dept with a request to use a nearby reserve for beach user parking.

In the event of failure of these initiatives the NSBUA will be forced to act independently. The introduction of a bus shuttle service from a nearby car park at weekends in the Peak summer period is to be raised with the MTT. Other money raising activities will also be investigated.

The NSBUA sees no reason why it should be viewed differently to other recreational groups within the Community, such as golf or bowling or surf clubs. The Association would therefore like to see a positive response from the appropriate Government bodies, especially in view of the changing
