### "A POLITICIAN'S PROMISE"

One day, when I stop banging my head on the wall, maybe I will learn not to trust a promise from elected representatives. One recent example is where the Nedlands City Council decided to upgrade the Swanbourne foreshore. A joint submission from all the beach users was accepted and agreed to on an 8 to 3 vote. There were also plans for a "Yacht Club" venue to be built on top of the Surf Club for the America's Cup - all to revert to the Surf Club free, after the Cup.

Following a petition of 316 local residents (who never use its beach facilities) and some political pressure, the Council removed from the plan anything that was of benefit to the nudists, i.e. parking area, toilet/shower block, consolidated pathways. And I was stupid enough to believe that beaches were for the public, not just ratepayers.

The Minister for Lands and Surveys, Mr. McIver, also refused permission for the new Surf/"Yacht" Club complex (worth \$1.2 million). The residents were happy. However the State Government Cabinet overruled this and in keeping with its policy has allowed building to proceed. At least somebody has some common sense. The residents are now upset again. Maybe the Government will see fit to provide parking and toilets like any other beach. But they might change their minds again.
